Politics and The American Legion

The American Legion is a non-partisan organization. Your uniform cap or other items with the Legion Emblem, are NOT TO BE WORN at political rallies or to support a candidate.

National Constitution Article II, Section 2
THE AMERICAN LEGION shall be absolutely nonpolitical and shall not be used for the dissemination of partisan principles nor for the promotion of the candidacy of any person seeking public officer or preferment.

Dept. of ND Constitution Article III, Section 1
This Department and Posts thereof shall be politically non-partisan and shall not be used for the dissemination of partisan principles or for the promotion of the candidacy of any person seeking public office or preferment. Nothing contained in this provision, however, shall restrict the Department, Posts, or individual members from appearing before legislative bodies in order to promote, wherever practical, military or veteran's affairs. Such appearance shall be in accordance with the applicable laws of the State of North Dakota regulating such activity.

Plaque awards are also presented to the four finalists in the State Contest. In addition, our State Champion will receive the C. W. Leifur Traveling Trophy for display at the winner's school.

National All State Champions will compete at the National Oratorical Contest under a new 3-round format. This year's National Contest will be held in Indianapolis, IN, on the IUPUI (Indiana University-Purdue University Indianapolis) Campus. All contestants and chaperones will arrive at the IUPUI Conference Center Hotel on Friday, April 5, 2019, where they will be housed. The first and second rounds of competition will be held on Saturday, April 6 beginning with nine separate contests with 6 contestants each. The winners of these 9 contests will then advance to the second round. All contestants participating in the first round will receive a \$1,500 scholarship. Each first round winner who advances to and participates in the second round, but does not advance to the final round, will receive an additional \$1,500 scholarship. Those contestants eliminated in the first and second rounds will remain and become members of the audience. The three (3) second round winners will participate in the Finals on Sunday, April 7 and have an opportunity to earn scholarships of: 1st Place - \$18,000; 2nd Place - \$16,000; 3rd Place - \$14,000. A banquet honoring all contestants will be held Sunday afternoon at the IUPUI Conference Center. All contestants and chaperones will then depart Indianapolis late Sunday afternoon April 7.

So You Want To Be A Delegate To The National Convention?

By virtue of the Constitution and By-Laws of the National American Legion, the Department of North Dakota is entitled to approximately 21 delegates each year.

The selection process for Delegates takes place annually at the Department Winter Conference by the Delegate Selection Committee. According to the Department Constitution and By-Laws, the Commander, Adjutant and Alternate National Executive Committeeman shall be included as delegates by virtue of office. In addition, the following individuals are automatically enrolled in the selection process:

- Immediate Past Department Commander**
- 3 Outgoing Department Vice Commanders**
- 10 District Delegates and Alternates elected at Spring District Meetings**

The remaining delegates are selected from individual applications made prior to the Department Convention. Individuals not selected will be listed as alternates with the potential to be elevated if a delegate is unable to attend. Each delegate will be provided with expenses for roundtrip airfare not to exceed \$250.00. Any delegate that is compensated by National Headquarters for attending the Convention shall not receive the Department allowance. Alternates may also choose to travel to the National Convention at their own expense.

To assist individuals wishing to be considered for delegate selection, we have developed the attached application form. An individual can use this form or can send a letter into the Department Headquarters to arrive at least one week before the Winter Conference.

EXPECTATIONS OF DELEGATES TO NATIONAL CONVENTIONS

The Department Executive Committee adopted the following list of expectations at the 1995 Winter Conference. The list is to be provided to all interested members to be used in determining if they wish to be a department delegate to the National Convention.

- 1. Visit ND HQ room upon arrival to get registration packet and leave your room location information.**
- 2. Attend assigned committee meetings and prepare a brief report for the ND caucus.**
- 3. Attend pre-parade meeting and participate in parade if physically able to do so.**
- 4. Attend the scheduled ND Caucus on Tuesday afternoon.**
- 5. Maintain a reasonable presence and visibility on the convention floor in the ND area to provide input should there be a roll call vote through the close of business on Wednesday.**
- 6. Delegate expense allowance will be given out Wednesday on the convention floor.**
