## Plan Your Future Now

No one likes to talk about the future of not being here. But the truth is, there will come a time where we will all reach this point. Having a plan for your future and your loved ones can be an important piece of your legacy. So, what benefits are available through the VA?

**Burial Benefits.** The VA may pay for some burial expenses to include funeral, transportation, or plot/interment allowance for veterans. Veterans who are service connected automatically qualify (excluding those who have a bare to benefits). Veterans who are not service connected may still qualify. It is important to speak with a Veteran Service Officer (VSO) to discuss your options and apply.

**National Cemetery.** Veterans and spouses may be buried at National Cemeteries throughout the country. Most veterans are eligible to be buried at a National Cemetery (exception veterans with dishonorable discharges and those who have been convicted of capital crimes post service). The cost of the burial is no charge to the family and a headstone is included. The family would still be required to pay for any cost associated with the funeral itself.

**Headstones or Markers.** For veterans who wish to be buried at a local cemetery, the VA will provide a headstone or marker at no charge. Speak with a VSO to discuss what options are available and apply.

**Dependent Indemnity Compensation.** If the veteran passes away from a service-connected condition, a condition which could have been related to service, or had been service connected at 100% for 10 or more years, his/her spouse may be entitled to Dependent Indemnity Compensation (DIC). DIC flat rate paid each month similar service-connected compensation.
