DEPARTMENT HITS MEMBERSHIP GOAL AT 66.80%

The Third Target Date goal was 55% and congratulations to all 10 Districts for exceeding this percentage. The 4th District came out on top with 73.73% and the 3rd came in second with 69.14%.

The Central Region came in on top with 69.95% of goal followed by the Eastern Region with 67.09% and Third is the Western Region with 65.42%. The Department is at 66.80% of our 2025 goal.

There were 162 posts that either met or exceeded the Target Date goal same as last year.

Plaque awards are also presented to the four finalists in the State Contest. In addition, our State Champion will receive the C. W. Leifur Traveling Trophy for display at the winner's school.

National All State Champions will compete at the National Oratorical Contest under a 3-round format. This year's National Contest will be held in Hillsdale, Michigan, at the Hillsdale College Campus on May 16-18, 2025. All contestants and chaperones will arrive on Friday, May 16. The first and second rounds of competition will be held on Saturday, May 17 beginning with 9 separate contests. The winners of these 9 first-round quarter-final contests, advance to three second-round semi-final contests followed by the national final involving three finalists. All contestants participating in the first round will receive a \$2,000 scholarship. Each first-round winner who advances to and participates in the second round, but does not advance to the final round, will receive an additional \$2,000 scholarship. Those contestants eliminated in the first and second rounds will remain and become members of the audience. The three (3) second round winners will participate in the Finals on Sunday, May 18 and have an opportunity to earn scholarships of: 1st Place - \$25,000; 2nd Place - \$22,500; 3rd Place - \$20,000. A banquet honoring all contestants will be held Sunday afternoon. All contestants and chaperones will then depart late Sunday afternoon May 18.
