NEW MEMBER RECRUITMENT AWARDS

RECRUITER OF THE YEAR - Certify the membership worker in your post that signed up 5 new members. Regional winners will be given a special cap pin recognizing their recruiting efforts. The Department recruiter of the Year winner will receive mileage, hotel night and two tickets to Dept Banquet and a plaque from National. **GOLD/SILVER/BRONZE BRIGADE** - If you

GOLD/SILVER/BRONZE BRIGADE - If you should have a member who signs up 50 or more new members before May 13, they can be certified in the National Gold Brigade. If they sign up 25-49 new members they qualify for the National Silver Brigade. Certification deadline is May 13. If they sign up 15-24 they qualify for the National Bronze Brigade.

RETENTION AWARD - is awarded to the post in each post size category who recruits 5 or more new members in 2024 and renews them in 2025. The highest percentage of posts who retained these will win a \$100 cash award.

Go-Getters Certified - This is a reminder to the Post Adjutant's to be sure to get your go-getter certifications into Department by the deadline of April 15. If you need a form you can go to ndlegion.org and go to Dept. Forms and click on go-getter form.

Legislation: As I write this, the legislation session is happening. By the time you read this the results will be in.

We, NDAL, have a legislative representative, Nate Huntington. Nate has been instrumental in giving a voice on behalf of the NDAL. He has supplied written and oral testimony for as many bills as he could. When he was working his day job, I stepped in to give oral testimony, as well as written. Two of the bills we were working on were (1) opportunities for our ND public schools to offer The Pledge of Allegiance. Working with Representative Anna Novak, it passed. Congratulation Rep Novak!!!! (2) Then the Predatory or Shark claims bill. This has been a tough one. Again, Nate did testimony with the House and I to the Senate. At this point it has gone back for amendment. More to come and I hope the bill will pass in the way of which it will protect our ND veterans.

Both Nate and I were well received at the Legislative Session. Some interesting comments were made throughout our visit to the sessions. The one that was repeated the most was – "It is so great to see our Veterans here and NDAL is well represented. We need to see Veteran Organizations and we do looks for the hats." Thank you NDAL for your support and all the excellent events with your communities to be a contributing factor in the high praise NDAL receives.

AWARDS AVAILABLE FOR MEMBER RECRUITMENT

- **Regional Recruiter of the Year** (by Post Size Categories) 4 new member recruiters in each region who signed up the highest number of new members with a minimum of 5 will receive a special designed cap pin.
- Department Recruiter of the Year One individual selected from the Regional winners who signed up the most new members will receive travel allowance to the Dept Convention in Fargo to include round-trip mileage, one night hotel accommodations and honored. They will also receive a plaque from National and their name will be entered in the National competition for a chance to win a trip to the National Convention.
- **Gold Division Membership** Department award given to any recruiter who signs up 25 new members. They will receive a Gold Division Baseball Cap and Membership Shirt and Fleece Jacket.
- **Gold Platoon Membership** Department award given to any recruiter who signs up 15 new members. They will receive a Gold Platoon Baseball Cap and Membership Shirt.
- **Gold Squadron Membership** Department award given to any recruiter who signs up 5 new members. They will receive a Gold Squadron Baseball Cap.

NEW 2025 MEMBER RECRUITER CERTIFICATION

All new members must be enrolled by May 1st and their membership mailed to Department Headquarters by May 15th to qualify. A NEW MEMBER is defined as any member signed into The American Legion for 2025 that was not a member of The American Legion for the 2024 membership year. Therefore, reinstated members, who last paid dues in 2023 or earlier, are considered NEW MEMBERS. **You MUST include a list of names of new members recruited for each recruiter being certified for an award!!!!!
